

ADULT DAY CARE

PROGRAM BACKGROUND

Adult Day Care provides comprehensive health, social, supportive and therapeutic day services for residents age 60 and over who are functionally-impaired through an interdisciplinary team approach at community-based senior centers.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

Seniors who are experiencing a decrease in physical, mental or social functioning are eligible. Appropriate diagnoses may include physical problems, isolation, Alzheimer's disease or related dementias.



Fun for All

Adult Day Care is particularly appropriate for those families who want their loved ones to remain at home as long as possible but are experiencing difficulties providing for their care.

Adult Day Care provides opportunities for individuals to maintain or improve their functional abilities in a supervised, structured environment, which reduces isolation, enhances self-esteem and maximizes their potential.

SERVICES PROVIDED INCLUDE:

- Case management
- Information and referral
- Assistance with medication administration
- Personal care
- Health monitoring and counseling
- A hot noon meal, snacks and nutrition counseling
- Therapeutic activities



Pet Therapy

- Educational, social, health and recreational activities
- Outings and Field Trips
- Intergenerational activities
- Small group therapies for those with Alzheimer's disease and other dementias.

BENEFITS OF ADULT DAY CARE

- A safe, secure environment
- Enjoyable and educational activities with socialization and peer support
- Social setting reduces risk of depression caused by isolation and loss
- Prevention focus, including nutrition, safety awareness and health monitoring activities, and therapy reduce risks of falls and improve ability to live at home
- Research indicates participation in adult day care may slow cognitive loss
- Respite from caregiving maintains the caregiver's mental and physical health by providing relief from caregiving duties and the ability to continue employment
