



## Utilities Assistance

- **Low Income Energy Assistance Program - LIHEAP**

Home energy assistance is provided to low-income household which fall below 150% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines and crisis payments not to exceed \$600 per season. You may also qualify for help if you are currently receiving the following assistance:

- Supplemental Security Income
- Food Stamps

Call for an appointment at the Neighborhood Service Center nearest to you.

- **Elderly Home Energy Assistance Program - EHEAP**

Home energy assistance provided to households that contain an individual aged 60+ which have a heating or cooling emergency. Income must fall below 150% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines. Maximum amount is \$600. You may also qualify for help if you are currently receiving the following assistance:

- Supplemental Security Income
- Food Stamps
