Bring Crime Prevention to Work with You

Almost any crime that can occur in your neighborhood, in a parking lot, at a mall or in your home can happen at work. So it makes sense to practice prevention here too. Help make things safer for everyone by:

- Reporting broken lights or flickering bulbs, dimly lit corridors, doors that don't lock properly, broken windows, etc.
- Letting someone know when you'll be away from your work area so they realize your area will be unattended, so co-workers are can check if they hear noise or see visitors in your space.
- Checking the identity of strangers in your area – ask who they are visiting and see if you can help them find that person. If you are uncomfortable with someone, inform security or management about the encounter.
